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## Tender notice

### **Tender title: Construction of Ndego hillside irrigation project Kibare Block (630ha) in District of Kayonza, Eastern Rwanda.**

**Procurement Method: ICB**

**Source of funds: IFAD&SPAIN**

1. The Government of Rwanda has received a financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), Spain and Catholic Organization for Relief and Development Aid – the financing of which is being administered by IFAD and intends to apply a part of the proceeds of the financing to this procurement. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD’s approval, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement, as well as IFAD’s rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its officials, agents and employees shall be held harmless from and against all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any kind or nature brought by any party in connection with the Construction of Ndego hillside irrigation project KIBARE Block 630 Ha.
2. **The Construction of Ndego hillside irrigation project Kibare block 630 Ha includes the construction /installation of:**
  - i. Power Supply from grid to pump station and pivots.
  - ii. Electro-mechanical Works for the Pumping Stations
  - iii. Distribution Pipeline
  - iv. Centre Pivot Irrigation System
  - v. Dragline Sprinkler System
  - vi. Civil Works including Earthwork, Construction of reservoirs, construction of Pumping stations, Construction of staff accommodation, offices, canteen, post – Infrastructure (warehouse and mini-garage) , drainage systems and murrum roads

The construction works will take 24 months

3. This invitation for bids (IFB) follows the general procurement notice that appeared in [*UN Development Business and IFAD Website as well as UMUCYO E-Procurement System*] newspaper in February 2026], on the IFAD website and on the United Nations Development Business website (UNDB) in February 2026].
4. The employer now invites sealed bids from eligible entities (“bidders”) for the execution and completion of the Construction of Ndego hillside irrigation project KIBARE Block 630 Ha, which are being bid as a unit price contract based on the bill of quantities.
5. This IFB is open to all eligible bidders who wish to participate. Subject to the restrictions stipulated in the bidding document, eligible bidders may associate with other bidders to enhance their capacity to successfully carry out the works. The employer informs the bidders that specialist sub-contractors are allowed for Center Pivot and Dragline Sprinkler systems.
6. A contractor will be selected using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) method in accordance with the IFAD Procurement Handbook accessible at [www.ifad.org/project-procurement](http://www.ifad.org/project-procurement). The ICB process will include a review and verification of qualifications and past performance, including a reference check, prior to the contract award.
7. Please note that a pre-bid conference will be held as described in the bid data sheet (“BDS”), Section II of the bidding document.
8. Tender Documents in English may be obtained through Umucyo E-procurement system, via [www.umucyo.gov.rw](http://www.umucyo.gov.rw) from the date of publication. The interested bidder shall pay a non-refundable fee of





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ten thousand Rwandan Francs (10,000Frw) and the sum is to be deposited on any account number of RRA open in any commercial bank operating in Rwanda and linked to Umucyo system. **A compulsory site visit is scheduled on 31/03/2026** (not mandatory for bidders who have already obtained the site visit certificate during the initial tender process, as it remains valid) and will be conducted by KIIWP2 irrigation team The venue for departure is fixed at 10:00 am local time at KIIWP2 Kayonza Office (located near SILENT Hotel).

9. All bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security of **Fifty-Two Million Rwandan Francs (52,000,000 FRW)** or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency, issued by a financial institution recognized by the National Bank of Rwanda. Enquiries regarding this tender shall be sent to RAB/KIIWP2 through E-Procurement system, via [www.umucyo.gov.rw](http://www.umucyo.gov.rw) in the window **"Request for Clarifications"** not later than 14 days before the deadline for submission of bids, so that responses can be issued to all bidders not later than 7 days prior to the deadline for submission of bids .
10. Bids will be submitted online using the Umucyo e-procurement system as mentioned above not later than the date and time indicated in the e-procurement system concerning this tender. Late bids will be rejected by the Umucyo system automatically.
11. Bids will also be opened automatically by the e-procurement system on the date and time indicated in the e-procurement system. All bids shall be valid for a period of **120 days** after the deadline of bid submission. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Rwanda Law on Public Procurement.

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Pre-qualification notice

**Tender title: Construction of Ndego hillside irrigation project Ihema block (926ha) and Nasho block (911ha) in Kayonza District, Eastern Rwanda.**

**Procurement Method: ICB**  
**Source of funds: IFAD&SPAIN**

The Government of the Republic of Rwanda has received financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and the Kingdom of Spain administered by IFAD, toward the cost of the Kayonza Irrigation and Integrated Watershed Management Project – Phase II (KIIWP II). The Government intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the contract for the Construction of Ndego Hillside Irrigation Project – IHEMA (926 Ha) and NASHO (911 Ha) Blocks in Kayonza District, Rwanda. The use of any IFAD financing shall be subject to IFAD’s approval pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement, as well as IFAD’s rules, policies and procedures.

The works under this prequalification include, but are not limited to, power supply from the national grid to pump stations and irrigation systems; electro-mechanical works for pumping stations; construction of water intake structures and reservoirs; installation of distribution pipelines; installation of Centre Pivot Irrigation Systems; installation of Dragline Sprinkler Irrigation Systems; and civil works including earthworks, construction of pump stations and reservoirs, drainage systems, staff accommodation, offices, warehouse and mini-garage facilities, as well as access and murrum roads. The expected construction period is twenty-four (24) months.

The Employer now invites eligible contractors to submit applications for prequalification for the above-mentioned works. The objective of this prequalification process is to identify and shortlist qualified contractors with proven technical, financial, and managerial capacity to successfully execute large-scale irrigation infrastructure works of similar nature and complexity. Only applicants that are prequalified will be invited to submit bids in the subsequent Invitation for Bids.

The procurement will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) in accordance with the IFAD Procurement Handbook and the Rwanda Law on Public Procurement. Eligible firms may associate in the form of a joint venture, consortium, or association to enhance their qualifications. Specialist sub-contractors are permitted, particularly for Centre Pivot and Dragline Sprinkler Systems.

Interested applicants shall demonstrate experience by **providing similar irrigation infrastructure projects of comparable scale and complexity within the last ten years; proven experience in electro-mechanical installations and pressurized irrigation systems; adequate financial capacity including average annual turnover and access to financial resources; availability of qualified technical personnel and key equipment; and a sound litigation and contract performance history.** Detailed qualification criteria are provided in the Prequalification Document.

Requests for clarification shall be submitted through the same system under the window "Request for Clarifications" not later than fourteen (14) days before the deadline for submission of applications, and responses will be issued to all applicants not later than seven (7) days before the submission deadline. Applicants are advised that this is not an Invitation for Bids, and only prequalified firms will be invited to participate in the subsequent bidding process.
